



High & Dry Farm is a Certified Organic market garden. Our 20 acre property sits on the south facing slope of the Skykomish river valley. We grow a diverse variety of vegetables and fruit on an intensely cultivated 1 acre section of the property. 2500 square feet of our garden lies in “high tunnel” unheated greenhouses, allowing us to produce vegetables 12 months of the year. Our approach to agriculture combines the contrasting sensibilities the farm’s owners - Mark Bothwell, a PhD molecular biologist, and Jana Harris, a widely published poet. We pay careful attention to the principles of sustainable agriculture, recognizing that healthful food is best grown on healthy soil. Healthy soil is not just “dirt”. It is a complex biological ecosystem including organisms that create a soil structure that allows vegetables to extract the nutrients that they, and you, require.
